(2022)</li> <li>Oncology was the first department to trial food boxes for those patients screened for food insecurity. (2023)</li> <li>Bayhealth started giving low sodium, low sugar food boxes to staff in December 2022, inpatients in March 2023, and Outpatients in September 2023. This program was designed as a stopgap for when a patient is identified as food insecure and when the long term solutions, such as the food bank, start. (2023)</li> <li>BHMG Primary Care quality metrics improved across all chronic disease and preventative care screenings from CY 2021 to 2023, with readmission rates decreasing each year. (2021-2023)</li> <li>Bayhealth partnered with Unite Delaware to refer those inpatients and outpatients with SDoH needs to local resources. After Unite DE referral with intervention, almost half of all patients had zero ED/IP use in the next 6 months. (2022-2023)</li> <li>In Fiscal Year 2024, approximately 1,000 patients were referred to Unite Delaware. (2024)</li> </ul>	
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
